As our Church teaches, you, the primary caretakers of these young disciples, are also the primary Catechists in their lives, and in our Faith Formation ministries.

What we do here at Queen of the Apostles only supplements what you teach, and put into action, in your lives and theirs. Therefore, it is necessary that you and your children covenant with the parish community to the following:

Regular Mass Attendance: Much of what each person learns about their faith happens through regular liturgical participation. You and your children need to make every effort to make regular Mass attendance and Holy Day liturgies part of your family's faith activities, along with the Faith Formation classes and events.

Class attendance, preparation, and discipline – All students are expected to attend class every time it takes place. If you and your children cannot be at class, please contact their Catechists, or the Director of Faith Formation, so that the church knows why you are not there. Please also make sure you and your children are prepared for class each Sunday- if there was any work taken home that you or your children were expected to complete, please make sure it has been done. If your children cannot behave in class as would be expected, you may be asked to complete their Faith Formation at home.

I understand the expectations listed in this covenant, and promise that I and my family will live up to them to the best of our abilities.
