How else did we help?

1,255 families were given clothing, furniture and household items
(families may visit our warehouse up to six times per year)

155 children in 75 families were adopted for Christmas through our Angel Tree Program.



105 children in 54 families started school with brand new backpacks filled with supplies



35 elderly clients were treated to a fully cooked Thanksgiving meal delivered to their homes by BCO volunteers. In December, those same clients received holiday gift bags filled with seasonal treats and items they could use all year.

How much food did we distribute?

120,419 pounds of food were given to 1,056 families.
We fed 2,538 individuals!
(families may receive food every two months.)
