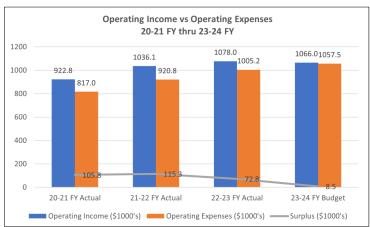
Results for July 2022 - June 2023

Queen of the Apostles continues to be in good financial condition. The following is a summary of our key financial results:

Available Cash - Our available cash at year end totaled \$565,736 (which included \$131,629 In checking + \$486,823 in savings – \$52,716 of fiduciary obligations).

Operating Results - Operating income for the year totaled \$1,078,044 with expenses of \$1,005,166 resulting in \$72,878 of surplus. Offertory was the largest part of our income with a total of \$1,009,836 (an increase of 5.0% compared to last year). Our expenses for the year were maintained within our budget (which is an

indicator of good expense management by Father Paul and our church staff).



Capital Results – The mortgage for our new church was paid off in January as the result of a generous estate gift coupled with our continuing pledge payments and capital gifts. As previously communicated, our new church was completed in January of 2020 at a cost of \$4.1M which was paid for with \$3.3M from our savings and an \$800,000 mortgage to cover the balance.

Also, our Fundraiser Auction Benefit was very successful with \$83,544 raised for campus beautification. As a result of this fundraiser and other gifts, we are starting the 23-24 FY with \$215,736 in our Capital Fund.

DSA Campaign – In 2022, our assessment for DSA was \$111,365 (with \$89,265 collected and \$22,100 paid from our savings). There were 247 families participating.

Priest Retirement Collection – In 2022, our assessment for Priest Retirement was \$27,640 (with \$17,195 collected and \$10,445 paid from our savings).

Our Plan Going Forward

Financial Planning Targets – Our 5-year financial plan ensures that we maintain an adequate cash position to manage our church financial needs. For the 23-24 FY, our goal is to maintain \$550,000 in available cash with \$50k for Operating Cash, \$200k for Operating Reserves, \$100k for the PPE Fund (plant, property, and equipment), and \$200k for our Capital Fund. Presently, we fully meet this goal with \$565,736 available.



Balanced Budget – Our goal is to always have a balanced budget with operating income greater than operating expenses. For the 23 -24 FY, our budget for income is \$1,066.000 with expenses of \$1,057,473. Based on our recent experience, we expect to achieve a surplus for the year.

Capital Income – Even though our church mortgage is paid off, we will continue to have capital needs to improve our church (such as stain glass windows, campus beautification, and other improvement projects). To meet these needs, we will continue our fundraising efforts (including gifts to the Capital Fund and our fundraisers).

DSA Campaign – Our 2023 DSA assessment is \$109,149. To date, we are approximately \$30k short of our assessment with 201 families participating. At the end of the campaign, any shortfall will be paid from our savings. To meet our assessment, we need better participation. If you have not yet contributed, please prayerfully consider participation in the campaign.

Priest Retirement Collection – is scheduled for September 16th and 17th. Our assessment this year is \$29,535 which is greater than one week of our offertory. Any shortfall will be paid from our savings. Please support this important collection.

In summary, Queen of the Apostles remains in good financial condition. We request your continued support to meet our financial needs as outlined above. Thank you for your generosity!
