3. Father Frank Update - Keith

Father Frank is recovering well and looks forward to returning. Father is at 85%. We will continue meal train through the end of August.

4. Grizzlies Game Update – Scott Phillips

We had a great turn out. We sold a few more tickets in 2018, but had higher attendance in 2019. The church raised \$1,500 from this event.

5. Building Update- Guests Stu LaFrancis and Chrissy Glisson presented - All

Stu and Chrissy joined us to review the current state of the building progress of the church.

- We are on-time and on-budget, currently 50 percent complete.
- We are tracking for end-of-year completion and expect dedication to take place in February 2020.
- Absent any surprises, we should be able to save \$100,000 on dirt.
- We continue to have a strong relationship with our contractors and building partners/vendors.
- We have received an excellent response from parishioners and our community from social media posts, videos, pictures, etc.
- Pastoral Council was able to view the new tabernacle, cross, paintings, flooring and paint colors that will be used in the new church.

- Pastoral Council took a tour of the new church to view the progress and was very impressed with the work that has already been completed. No outstanding questions.
- What will happen to the old church? It will remain a chapel for use by the parish and will also allow more space for administrative offices.

 - The strong story teller who can connect biblical readings to today's world and inspire parishioners to take those lessons and apply them to everyday interactions.
 - A leader with the ability and passion to put a priority on personal, spiritual and intellectual growth for themselves and our church community.
